

Privacy Policy August 2020

Barbara Bagley is the trading name for Barbara Bagley Art. We sell original paintings, prints, greetings cards and models designed and produced by Barbara Bagley exclusively. We take the privacy of our contacts, customers and website visitors very seriously and therefore set out in this policy our position regarding certain privacy matters and the use of cookies on this website. This policy provides an explanation as to what happens to any personal data that you share with us by phone, email or that we collect from you directly via this website. All data shared by a contact, customer or visitor to us is covered by this policy.

This policy is occasionally updated so we suggest you re-review from time to time. Certain businesses are required under the data protection act to have a data controller. 1 – Information we collect

In operating our business, we may collect and process the following data about you:

- 1.1 Information provided to us when you communicate with us for any reason.
- 1.2 Information that you provide such as when you register to receive information such as a catalogue or newsletter or when you contact us.
- 1.3 Details of your visits to our website and the resources that you access including, but not limited to, traffic data, location data, weblog statistics and other communication data.

2 – Use of Cookies

On occasion, we may gather information about your computer for our services, and to provide statistical information regarding the use of our website.

Such information will not identify you personally, it is statistical data about our visitors and their use of our site. This statistical data does not identify any personal details whatsoever. It is used by us to analyse how visitors interact with the website so that we can continue to develop and improve our services.

We may gather information about your general internet use by using cookies automatically downloaded to your computer that contain information transferred to your computer's hard drive. All computers have the ability to decline cookies. In most cases, this can be done by activating the setting on your browser which enables you to decline the cookies. Please note that should you choose to decline cookies, you may experience issues when accessing particular areas of our website.

3 – Use of your information

- 3.2 To meet our contractual commitments to you.
- 3.3 To notify you about any changes to our business or products that may affect our service.

3.4 If you are an existing customer, we may contact you with information about goods and services similar to those which were the subject of a previous sale to you.

3.5 We may use your data so that you can be provided with information about unrelated goods and services which we consider may be of interest to you. We may contact you about these goods and services by any of the methods that you consented to at the time your information was collected.

3.6 If you are a new customer, we will only contact you when you have provided consent and only by those means you provided consent for.

4 – Storing your personal data

4.1 Data that is provided to us is stored on secure servers.

4.2 The transmission of information via the internet is not completely secure and therefore we cannot guarantee the security of data sent to us electronically and the transmission of such data is entirely at your own risk.

5 – Disclosing your information

5.1 We may disclose your personal information to third parties:

5.2.1 Where we are legally required to disclose your information.

5.2.2 To assist fraud protection and minimise credit risk.
